

The ISO EN 7010 standard came into force on 1 January 2014. It aims to harmonise the graphic symbols of safety pictograms at international level. All safety signal manufacturers around the world must use the same model

The objective?

This global harmonization allows for more consistency and therefore universal recognition of signals by the public. Thus, the European standard (EN) guarantees a message that can be understood by everyone, regardless of language. The panels covered by EN ISO 7010 are therefore particularly suitable for places where several nationalities coexist, such as public administrations, the headquarters of large companies or public places.

Thanks to the ISO EN 7010 standard, all employees are confronted with the same symbols and colours with regard to fires, first aid, evacuation, hazards, prohibitions and obligations.
